

REQUIREMENTS FOR CONSIDERATION FOR INDUCTION INTO THE CALIFORNIA JAYCEES ORDER OF THE TIGER:

1. Be a member of the California Jaycees for minimum of three years.
2. Be recognized by fellow Tigers for serving the Jaycees with distinction, leaving a lasting, positive impact on your Chapter, the California Jaycees and beyond.
3. All nominees shall be sponsored by three Tigers in good standing, including a minimum of one from the inductee's home chapter and one from outside the chapter, who are willing to attest to the Candidate's worthiness. They also agree to serve as the inductee's Sponsors.
4. Be willing to continue to serve the Jaycees through this new affiliation with the Tigers (mentor, trainer, Individual Development Competition Judge, Ambassador of Success).
5. All applications shall be presented to the Terrible Tiger or appropriate Board member prior to the beginning of the quarterly Board meeting. Referral of the applicant for membership shall be by a majority vote of Board members present at the quarterly executive meeting. Any exceptions or variation to the nomination and referral process will be handled individually by the Terrible Tiger.
6. No membership request shall be deemed completed unless accompanied by the application fee of \$50.00.

2013-14 INDUCTION PROCESS: A TIGER TOAST

Induction into the Order of the Tiger will be a TOAST to the new Tiger and their accomplishments! The Tiger Tamer meets with the Candidate and Sponsor(s) prior to the meeting to provide a brief orientation to the new process and obtain some information (i.e. drink preference) for the Toast. No more blindfolds, chant-learning, or waterboarding (just kidding!). Instead it's a light-hearted, rowdy celebration of the candidate's accomplishments and a fun excuse to roast the sponsors if you want! Details will be shared in the Tiger Roar.

Attendance at quarterly meetings can be a challenge for inductions. Therefore, it is possible for a new Tiger nominee to be inducted and presented with their pin at a local chapter meeting with prior arrangement and agreement by the Terrible Tiger.
